3 Tips to make your activities section stand out

- 1. Use stronger verbs (Ex: mentor, organize, lead)
- 2. Develop better (and perhaps a bit more) content
- 3. Demonstrate skills & values, especially leadership skills!

Ask yourself these questions to enhance your descriptions.

- What did I do?
- What problems did I solve?
- What lessons did I learn?/What skills did I gain?
- What impact did I have?
- How did I apply what I learned?

Don't forget to use the <u>additional comments section</u> if you participated in an activity before HS and continued during HS or if you had planned to participate in an activity, but certain circumstances did not allow you to (ex: soccer season was cancelled because of COVID-19). You can also use this section to note if one of your activities helped you choose or helped to solidify your major/career choice. These are **not** the only comments you can make in this comments section, your counselor/college advisor can help you figure out what else/if anything needs to be included here.
